Data collection: October 2014 to January 2015




Methodology :

- Investigations offered-accepted and rejected




Distribution of hearing loss:

| | Mild | Moderate | Severe- profound | Total |
|------------|----------|----------|---------------------|-------|
| Bilateral | 10 | 14 | 7 | 31 |
| Unilateral | 4 | 3 | 3 | 11 |
| | 14 (33%) | 17 (40%) | 11(26%) | 42 |




